#### **NELSON FIRE RESCUE**

#### Can I use a portable fireplace or "campfire" in my yard?

While Nelson's burning bylaw prohibits open burning (including campfires and bonfires), the natural gas/propane "fire pits" popping up nowadays ARE acceptable. These gas/propane fire pits require CSA approval and must be properly installed prior to use. Note that these are NOT the same as the "chimneys" or other outdoor fireplaces (portable or not), which are used to burn wood. Wood and/or waste burning in these pits, even if they are designed for such use, is strictly prohibited.

#### **UPHILL VOLTAGE CONVERSION**

Nelson Hydro is continuing with the voltage conversion in uphill Nelson. This upgrade of the distribution voltage from 4kV to 25kV accomplishes several things. The most important of these accomplishments is standardizing to one distribution voltage (currently there are three). We can provide power to 25kV distribution neighborhoods from either of our Mill St. or Rosemont substations. This will be a more reliable configuration than the single point of supply from Mill Street substation for the older 4kV systems. You will likely see power line crews at work in uphill areas this summer as we complete this last big piece of
