Stores-To-Shores Hall Street Project Update – Week of March 26 - 30, 2018

The foreshore works have been progressing rapidly this week and the stairs are starting to shape up. The lowest footing of the stairs has been poured. More concrete is to come in the following week. The low lake levels continue to favor our progress, and stabilizing rip rap has been placed on the foreshore.

Works planned for the week of March 26 to 30 will remain within the parking area and along the foreshore near the gazebo. Traffic disruption at Lakeside and Hall will be limited, but due to the temporary gravel surface in this intersection (as well as pathways along the waterfront near the gazebo), drivers and pedestrians should be mindful of the uneven surface and proceed cautiously through the area.

Vehicle and pedestrian access to the boat houses remains south of the gazebo. The dog walk area has been closed off for non-project related reasons. The work zone is defined, signed, and fenced. Please go slow and use caution in this area.

The City remains committed in keeping traffic moving and ensuring access to businesses along Hall Street and Lakeside Drive. The City requests that the public remain patient during the construction and to continue to support the businesses along Hall Street and Lakeside Drive.
