YOUTH CENTRE





COMMUTER PARKING – PILOT PROJECT

Do you commute to downtown by car and need to find reliable all-day parking?

To improve availability for those looking for all-day parking, the City has recently introduced all-day metered parking on the 300 Block of Cedar Street (between Vernon and Front Streets). These prime spots are only a few minutes' walk from downtown. The meters charge a flat \$5 rate for the day, which is the same rate as the parkade. The commuter parking allows you to leave your vehicle for up to 12 hours without moving it. This parking is open to anyone who needs a place to park their car for the day while working, shopping or visiting in Nelson.



JULY 3RD REMINDER

PROPERTY TAX TIME

Tax notices are being mailed this week. If you have not received your notice by the second week of June, please contact the City at (250) 352-8248.

Property taxes are due **Tuesday, July 3rd, 2018**. Payment can be made on-line through most financial institutions, through the City's website, by mail or in person. City Hall is open 8:30am to 4:30pm, Monday to Friday, but will be closed Monday, July 2nd in lieu of Canada Day.

A reminder to also claim your Home Owner Grant, if eligible, at www.nelson.ca or at City Hall **prior to the tax due date**.

OPERATIONS

TRIMMING BOULEVARD TREES

Residents are reminded to NOT trim City-owned trees growing on City-owned land such as boulevards and laneways. The Municipal Tree Bylaw states that a person could be fined up to \$10,000. 
