For the Holiday Season Nelson Fire & Rescue Services would like to remind you that a fire can occur in any home – even yours!

Some important safety tips:



- Ensure all Smoke Alarms and Carbon Monoxide Alarms are in working order – be sure to replace your batteries.
- Consider using new LED style candles – they are attractive and very safe.
- Keep matches and lighters out of the reach of children.
- Make sure your wood stove or fireplace flues and chimneys are cleaned annually.
- Use CSA rated space heaters and ensure an adequate clearance between the heater and other materials – minimum 1 metre.
- Water your live Christmas tree daily – and be sure to remove the tree when it becomes dry.
- Use extension cords properly. Do not overload or run beneath carpets.
- Think Fire Safety!

OPERATIONS

STREET SNOW PLOWING

First priority for snow plowing is to clear and sand emergency routes, major access routes and streets in the downtown area.

From November 1st to April 30th each year, vehicles must be parked on the odd-numbered side of the street on odd-numbered dates and be parked on the even-numbered side of the street on even-numbered dates, within residential zones, to allow the City's snow clearing operations to plow close to the curbs and maintain maximum street width.

CITY SIDEWALK SNOW REMOVAL

Designated, high traffic sidewalks will be cleared of snow by the Operations Department. Please note that only one side of the sidewalk will be cleared of snow in this program. Every business owner or resident shall remove accumulation of snow or ice upon sidewalks **not later than 11:00am** daily (except Sundays and Holidays).
