

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NELSON
TEMPORARY USE PERMIT APPLICATION

TAKE NOTICE that the Corporation of the City of Nelson will be considering a resolution to grant a temporary use permit to allow for a change in liquor license at the Nelson Brewing Company to operate a “neighbourhood pub”.

The proposal would allow the applicant to change their liquor license to allow for more than just sampling of products. The interior footprint of the pub area will not be increased and occupant capacity will remain at 30 people. Hours of operation will be limited from 11am to 9pm. The temporary use permit would allow the applicant to operate a neighbourhood pub for up to 3 years.
