

- Our City crews maintain over 67 km of roadways in the winter months.
- School zones are accessible through our Priority One road network during snow events.
- There will be **NO PARKING** at the Lakeside parking lot beside the soccer fields for the duration of the winter months. This area will be utilized as a snow dump for our winter operations. Please utilize the parking lot near the orange bridge (BOB) for access to Lakeside Park.

SNOW CLEARING: As per City bylaw, residents and businesses are required to remove snow and ice from sidewalks bordering their property or business by 11:00am each day.

DOWNTOWN PARKING: Please do not park downtown between 4:00am and 7:00am to allow our crews to clean-up the downtown core.



Priority Plowing Routes

- 1 Emergency routes/bus routes/downtown core (until it stops snowing)
- 2 Streets considered major hills & critical utility routes
- 3 Other streets and cross streets, including intersections, high pedestrian-use sidewalks, bus stops, handicapped parking spots and fire hydrants
- 4 Dead-end streets
- 5 Lanes and dead-end lanes



SAFETY TIP: When crews are working, please obey all signage and give equipment the right-of-way. This will ensure the safety of staff and residents during our snow removal operations.
